A DAY FOR DANCING pressed the pace, bid outside that one at the top of the stretch and drew clear under a hand ride. FAITHFUL ONE closed four-wide late turn and finished determinedly outside. D' COUNTRY was hustled along between horses and finished all out through the stretch. TRIPPI RULES had speed, sprinted clear into the turn, set a pressured pace, was no match when challenged at the top of the stretch and tired. COMPADRE'S REBEL broke awkwardly, was hard ridden along the rail on the turn, altered course inside the 1/8 pole to avoid the fallen rider and finished gamely. JAVA FLOW, hustled early, saved ground, was checked inside the 1/8 pole to avoid MAYFIELD ROAD and evened out. MAYFIELD ROAD, off a step slowly, closed between rivals upper stretch, clipped heels with a fading horse inside the 1/8 pole and unseated her jockey. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN RESULTED IN TRIPPI RULES BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED LAST FORE INTERFERING WITH MAYFIELD ROAD.
